Migration and human mobility are cross-cutting issues cover 11 goals in the SDGs, and closely related to the central, transformative promise to "Leave No One Behind" in the SDGs. However, there is no global governance of migration and human mobility, which is still largely dependent on the policies of sovereign nations. In this lecture, we examine global and regional governance of migration and human mobility, and learn what ideology supports sustainable migration policy in some economic zones. And this lecture also examines the outbreak of anti-immigrant sentiment in migrant-receiving societies.
