授業のねらいとカリキュラム上の位置付け(一般学修目標) / Course Objectives	教育目標 / Educational Goals				
<p>From the latter half of the 20th century, a consciousness of environmental concern took root, and Earth Day was celebrated for the first time in 1970. With the advances in science and technology, the world connected by blogs and SNSs (the Web) became smaller, and warnings from the natural ecology resonated with many people, promoting the idea that ecological concepts and frameworks should also be incorporated into legal policies.</p> <p>This lecture begins with an explanation of the two different areas of “environmental law policy” and “ecology,” which is followed by an explanation of ecosystem-friendly legal policy. This course takes up the relevant issues in three periods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 the original period of ecological debate in the mid-century years from 1950 to 1970, 2 the first period of serious social/political interactions after Earth Day in 1970, and 3 the following decade of repeated trial and error. <p>Focusing on these major periods makes it clear that introducing new concepts and policy regimes into law is time-consuming and that careful consideration should be given to the progress and implementation of such efforts.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understanding the style and composition of scientific papers and becoming accustomed to the typical usage of technical terms in English. • Understanding the process of how two distinct areas of legal policy and ecology have resulted in ecosystem-friendly legal policies. • Learning how to introduce new concepts or regimes into legal policies. • In designing legal policies, there are many situations that require a balance among multiple purposes and considerations. Accordingly, an important goal is to consider priorities and gain a perspective on policy formulation and legislation.
