The program will provide students with a wideranging experience of the interlinkages among multiple fields such as economic, social, environmental, cultural, and human aspects of sustainability. From this program, students will learn to develop skills to design and communicate solutions to sustainability challenges and deepen their understanding of the role of sustainability studies in addressing current problems to global change that creates a future pathway as sustainable development experts. Our teaching and research profile combines forward-thinking scientific knowledge across inter- and multidisciplinary academics in the sustainable development of both the social and natural sciences. Through this program, students gain critical thinking and can enhance their problem-solving capacity to contribute to a sustainable and prosperous society.

- 3. List the name of the faculty members who can be expected to be your supervisor(s).


